- *Manage and supervise efficiently the workforce*

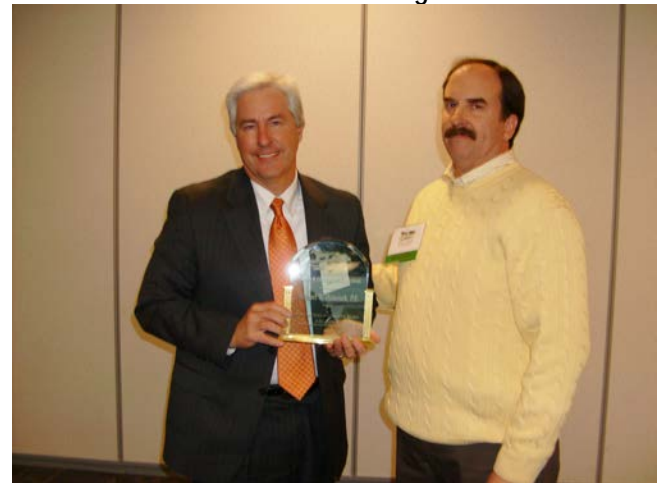

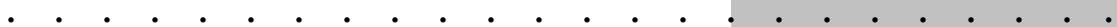
