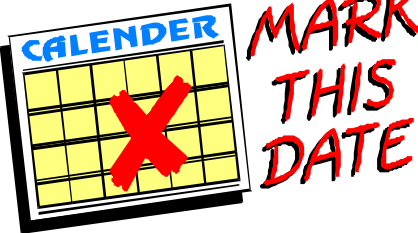

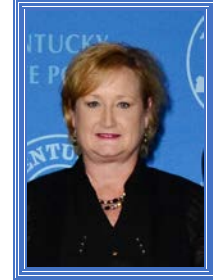

CALL TO ORDER: President Debbie Fisher called the meeting to order.

PRESENTATION OF MINUTES: President (Former Secretary) Debbie Fisher presented minutes, Latrese Bellamy made motion to accept minutes; Mary Pascal seconded.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Treasurer Robinil Jameson presented financial report. Also mentioned that we may need to move the banking accounts to another institutions being that the current institution has gone through so many changes that appears to unstable. Suggestions were made to move to Independence Bank or Commonwealth Credit Union. The treasurer's report is to be filed for financial review.

KSCPM members recently enjoyed a presentation about leadership skills and challenges by a panel of current and former state government executives for the Spring Luncheon on May 15 at the Berry Hill Mansion in Frankfort. The panel included: Gene Childress, Senior Consultant at Center for Quality People and Organizations, Inc. (former Executive Director GSC); Jolene Parris, Executive Director, Office of Human Resource Management, KYTC; and Patty Dunaway, Vice President/Office Executive of Michael Baker Engineering (former KYTC State Highway Engineer). They also answered questions from their perspective as a leader about the and other state government issues.

- Make sure you know what is expected of you and of the organization and the person over you. Also know what those that report to you expect. Have trust and respect between everyone. Have open communications.
- Budget restraints have limited and reduced the initiatives to motivate. To navigate through limited funds, celebrate wins with compliments and food day, etc. Encourage team building. Give good news at the end of the day and bad news during the beginning of the day.
- Discuss the issue not the individual. Make sure you are willing to change if you are proven wrong or in error.

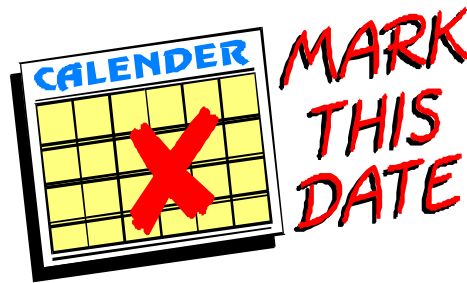
